Homework

English

In our English lessons this term we will be studying a range of exciting texts including: picture books, narratives and plays. We will be inspiring the children's writing through a variety of stimuli.

Maths

Pupils will be revising all aspects of Mathematics including: time, measures and data handling, alongside the 4 operations. We will be looking at problem solving and written arithmetic skills too. Please keep practising times tables and mental recall of facts at home.

Science

Pupils will be learning about 'Living things and their habitats' in the first term and a biography of a scientist in the second half term. Towards the later part of the Summer Term Sex Education will be taught- more details to follow.

Religious Education

During this term pupils will learn about creation stories and how is faith expressed through worship.



Computing

Pupils will be learning about how to keep safe online through ongoing e-safety lessons. Children will be using their prior knowledge and applying advanced skills in Spreadsheet design. The term will culminate with the design and making of their own website about France.

Design Technology

We will have a DT Unit this term, with the focus of designing and making a vehicle that is able to move 1 metre unaided.

French

In French the children will learn a range of French vocabulary based around the themes of sport, transport, ordering food, and future plans. The children will be encouraged to use their French on the residential!



Humanities

This term we are investigating creative solutions to the environmental and sustainability challenges that Earth faces, and the role that technology can play in resolving these issues.

Art & Design

This term's art areas of study will include painting, sketching and oil pastels. The children will study the work of influential French artist Monet.

Music

For this term we will be concentrating on songs from our end of year production 'Panto Pandemonium'.



Physical Education

Throughout the term pupils will have the opportunity to learn the skills to participate and refine Athletic events. The children will also have the opportunity to develop team work skills through Cricket and Real PE will also be taught during this term.

Personal, Social, Health and Citizenship Education

Themes of study this term include: discussing diversity of the United Kingdom and communication using the internet. In the second half of the term the theme will be 'Moving On' where all children will be completing a series of lessons as part of a transition booklet.
