## Important Year 5 Events this term

## Homework

### English

The children will be using many different texts as stimulus for their writing including 'Dragonology'.



### Maths

Our focus for learning this term starts with statistics and then moves on to measurements. Please continue to learn your conversion facts as this will help in class. All topics will include fluency, reasoning and problem solving questions on perimeter, area, fractions, angles and shape this term.

### Science

We will continue to learn about properties and materials and then follow onto biographies of influential modern chemists. The second half of the term the children will study Earth and Space.

### Religious Education

Throughout the term we will be using The Bible as we learn more about people living as a Christian/proverbs and God's plan. We will also look at worship around the world and creed.

### Computing

In computing we will become web developers and create a simple internet safety web page. After this we will create a virtual learning space.

### Design Technology

The children will be learning about cooking and nutrition in DT—watch out Jamie Oliver!



### French



French this term will cover a variety of everyday situations and conversations including talking about themselves, food, clothes and holidays.

### Humanities

Children will be first looking at OS mapping and their local area—including research on a local environmental issue. We will then move on to study the ancient civilisation of the Mayans, we will find out how their culture and traditions contrast with our own western lifestyles.

### Art & Design

Our art and design will include using clay, water-colours, sketching, photography, textiles.

### Music

In music we will appreciate and understand a wide range of high-quality live and recorded music involving Jazz. As well as learning 'Joseph' songs.
