Important Year 5 Events this term

Home learning activities will be set each Wednesday to be handed in the following Monday. Homework consists of short topic related activities, maths, spellings and reading. Little and often is best! A homework book is provided. Please use no more than 2 pages to complete the weekly homework and encourage your child to write in best handwriting.

Home Learning

English

The children will be using many different texts as stimulus for their writing. They will be studying a variety of different authors to gain inspiration for their writing.

Maths

The children will extend their knowledge of a range of written calculation methods, develop problem solving skills and reasoning skills.

Science

We will finish our Earth and Space topic before our visit to PGL. We will then be learning about 'Animals, including humans', looking at the growth and development of different species including them! We will also look at 'Living things and their Habitats' concentrating on life cycles of animals and plants.



Religious Education

In R.E. we will be learning more about Islam focusing on how a mosque can help us to understand the Muslim faith and how the pillars of Islam live a good life.

Computing

Children will become digital artists this term by using a range of software to reflect tessellation and repeating patterns. They will also "develop their architecture skills," creating a virtual learning space. They will also be turning into cryptographers by studying codes and how to crack them!

Design Technology

The children will be learning about cooking and nutrition in DT this term creating biscuits. We will also develop young architects and engineers this term as we are looking at structures and mechanisms centred around our Anglo Saxon topic.



French



French this term will cover a variety of everyday situations and conversations including free time, holidays, and clothes.

Humanities

We will now move on to study the Anglo Saxons where they will be looking at their invasion into Britain: art and culture and the types of settlements they used.

Art & Design

This term the children will be getting creative with photo montages in the style of David Hockney. We will also be looking at the Bayeux Tapestry and Anglo Saxon art linking with textiles and weaving. Our focus artist will be William Morris and we will be doing some printing!

Music

In music the children will study and play along with a wide range of music genres, as well as composing their own interpretations of popular songs and styles.

Physical Education

This term the children will be trying their hands at a variety of sports and games. Children will be enjoying the summer weather with cricket, tennis and athletics!

Personal, Social, Health and Citizenship Education

To help the children become more rounded individuals, they will learn how to cope in different situations— how to make amends if they have done something unkind and understanding when something is their fault.
